IT'S NICE TO KNOW THERE ARE OTHER E-TECHS THAT R WILLING TO SHARE INFORMATION. GREAT JOB ON THE WEB SIGHT. I THOUGHT YOU MIGHT WANT TO ADD THIS IN YOUR POWER SUPPLY SECTION FOR THE JCM.

I HAVE FOUND QUITE A FEW OF THE POWER SUPPLIES WORKING WITH THE CAP REPLACEMENT BUT 1 HAVE ALSO ADDED THE K1445 AS A REGULAR REPLACEMENT. IF THIS TRANSISTOR IS WEAK OR SHORTED THE POWER SUPPLY OUTPUT WILL SHOW ALL THE WAY UP TO 12.18VDC BUT WHEN A LOAD IS PUT ON THE POWER SUPPLY THERE IS A VOLTAGE DROP QUICKLY TESTED UNDER INPUT TEST ON PE PLUS THE BV SHOULD LIGHT UP THANKS AGAIN
